
ADOPTING A CHALLENGING PET




Our family quit counting how much Ronan cost when the vet bills hit \$8,000. At that point, it was like checking the temperature during an Alberta Clipper. Who cares if it's -10 or -25? Cold is cold. Why measure your pain?

We met Ronan during an Alberta Clipper. February 2021 was brutally cold when we walked him behind Animal Allies. Ronan came to Animal Allies as a stray puppy with a wonky leg and no

backstory. The best guess was his left front leg was damaged when he was very young. Ronan could touch his paw to the ground, but it supported no weight and the paw stuck out to the side. His right leg did all the work.

Ronan is one of those challenging animals in the shelter system. They're often described in web listings as "Prefers a home without cats" or "Sometimes eats UPS drivers." Ronan impressed us on every visit. He's a goofy galoot. Ronan smothers you with so much love and charm you forget about the slobber, farts, and hair. We were smitten. We'd make room for this 65 lb.

Great Dane / Shetland pony mix. We were aware of his challenges, but we felt up for it. Ronan came home in late winter.

In our defense, we had no ideas how much surgeries cost. Our previous experience with vets was mostly checkups with the occasional crossing of the rainbow bridge. Now we were in the world of veterinary orthopedic care. Latin is the language of this world. Carpus. Valgus. Bi-oblique proximal ulnar ostectomy.

Why so much Latin? Ronan's injury stopped his radius from growing but not the ulna right next to it. One end of Ronan's growing ulna pushed his paw to the side (valgus) while the other end was dislocating his elbow. His swollen elbow warned of trouble. Dr. Lisa Jeanetta performed an urgent surgery at Dougherty Veterinary Clinic in Duluth on April 2nd. That saved his elbow from popping apart. At the end of the month, we road-tripped down to Blue Pearl in Arden Hills. Dr. Kathryn Kaufman cleaned out his elbow, did an ulnar ostectomy and fused together the wreckage of Ronan's wrist. The worst was to come.


Our growing hound-beast had to be restrained for eight weeks. No walks. No stairs. No furniture. No romping with our other dog. YOU try keeping a now-90 lb. puppy still for two months.

This is where it all paid off. The pain, boredom and drugs didn't dampen Ronan's charm. He should hate us for keeping him tied indoors during spring. Instead, we remain his Glorious Givers of Food and Scritches.

MICROCHIPPING REMAINS VITAL

IN REUNITING FOUND PETS WITH THEIR FAMILIES



We are grateful to the Duluth Superior Area Community Foundation for the \$10,000 grant to support our microchip clinics for the next year!

As part of our Return to Home initiative, in 2021 Animal Allies focused on one of the simplest ways to keep pets in their homes: microchipping!

Dogs and cats that get lost can travel long distances. There are many ways to get the word out about missing pets, from the traditional flyer on a telephone pole to social media posts that can reach thousands. However, because its unique number offers a direct way of contacting the owner, microchipping remains vital in reuniting found pets with their families.



All animals adopted through Animal Allies are microchipped. Shelter medical staff also offers microchipping of owned animals by appointment for \$25 throughout the year. In further efforts to make sure this service is accessible to all community members, we have been expanding our public chip

clinic work. This year, businesses and organizations like Ursa Minor Brewing, Thirsty Pagan Brewing, the Damiano Center, and Miller Hill Subaru helped us host over ten clinics offering free microchipping to local dog and cat owners, with no appointment required. We are so proud of this work and look forward to expanding further in order to ensure more missing pets can return safely to their homes.

During the course of chip clinics and appointments, we have come across some common misconceptions about how pet microchips work. Here are the most common myths many pet owners believe about microchips:

Myth: Microchips are tracking devices.

Truth: Unfortunately, chips have no GPS tracking capacity. A microchip only works as an identifier when read by a chip scanner. In order to check for a chip, stray pets should be brought to your nearest shelter or vet clinic to be scanned. Once the number is scanned, the owner's contact information can be retrieved and they can be reunited with their pet.

Myth: Microchipping is painful for pets.

Truth: It only takes a few seconds to implant a chip, and pets often don't even notice it's happening. More sensitive dogs and cats may flinch momentarily, but it is effectively the same as getting a shot. Microchips go under the skin behind the shoulder blades.

Myth: Microchips expire and need to be replaced.


Truth: Chips are designed to last for a pet's entire life. While you can enroll in annual programs through the microchip company for additional benefits, there should never be a need to replace, reactivate, or change a microchip once implanted.

Once a microchip is implanted in your pet, it should be set for life, without any maintenance or additional payments. However, microchips are no use in returning pets to their homes if they are not registered to the owner's current contact information.

Any time you move or change your phone number, it is vital to contact the microchip company to update this information. This can usually be done online or by phone.

Microchipping is becoming recognized as a basic component of responsible pet ownership. Through education and public outreach, Animal Allies hopes to help ensure that Northland pets have access to the important safeguard..

Animal Allies was excited to return to our biggest annual offsite adoption event, Love-A-Pet at Subaru! This year, the Miller Hill Subaru dealership hosted Animal Allies and four other rescues for a weekend of playing matchmaker between people and pets. And it was a huge success! Over the weekend, a total of 106 animals went to their new homes.

Animal welfare from throughout the region was represented: The Babinski Foundation of Pequot Lakes; Contented Critters, based in Makinen, MN; Lake County Humane Society from Two Harbors; and Ashland, WI's Chequamegon Humane Association.

Reduced adoption fees for the event help motivate those undecided about whether to adopt, and help bring more people in the door where they might fall in love with a pet.

In addition to lower fees, Love-A-Pet helps clear shelters by bringing increased traffic, especially to smaller rescues who don't have as many in-person visitors at their facilities. With several rescues gathered together, adopters could see more different pets and choose the best fit for their lifestyle.

On November 6, "Caturday," an amazing 76 cats and kittens from all five organizations found new families.

On Sunday, November 7, 30 dogs and puppies found were adopted (including senior yellow lab Omar, who had become a favorite during his two months at Animal Allies.)

Animal Allies retail and adoption staff were on hand, as well as our Youth Allies. MIX 108's Jeanne Ryan showed up both days to entertain visitors and hype the event. This year, we moved into the 21st century for our popular holiday photobooth: instead of the traditional print copies, finished photos were shared through a digital link. We are so thankful to our amazing Santa, Craig, and to photographer Liz of Bark Barn and Amy Louhela for continuing this festive tradition.

Local vendors manned booths to reach out to local animal lovers. Among them were Twin Ports Pet Sitters, Canal Bark, Riley Rue Pet Spaw, and Crank & Dasher Ice Cream.

It was a privilege to watch the animal rescue community come together to save over one hundred pets in one weekend—and have fun doing it!


